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# PROJECT AIMS



1. To improve by at least 70% the technical and institutional capacity of the 6 partner organizations, to raise awareness about social economy structures connected to the SDGs, and their entrepreneurial, social, and digital skills, aiming to facilitate up to 20% access for NEET youth to the green labor market and green social-economic structures

2. To provide specific tools for achievement at least a 30% increase in green entrepreneurship, creativity and employability skills for a minimum of 240 NEET and other disadvantaged rural, immigrant, refugees or national minority youth from six partner countries

3. To develop to 40% the social dimension of entrepreneurship in green sectors and online collaboration, essential for promoting solidarity and responsibility among young people from 6 countries

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# WHAT WILL WE DO

 **Eco-Friendly Organized Industrial Zone Visit** We will visit an organized industrial zone in the region that implements eco-friendly and sustainable production methods. This will allow participants to see how environmental awareness can be integrated into industry and production.

 **Cultural Nights** Participants will have the chance to share and discover different cultures through food, dance, music, and traditions. A great moment for intercultural learning and fun!

 **Green Activities** Various environmental and sustainability, entrepreneurship concepts -focused activities such as waste separation workshops, recycling practices, upcycling, permaculture, and climate action games will be organized throughout the project.

 **BRASOV Trip** We will visit the world-famous archaeological site of Brasov city-offers a unique opportunity to reflect on the relationship between humans, nature, and spirituality.

 **Many More Activities** In addition, we will organize reflections, team-building games, workshops, nature walks, and interactive sessions with the local community. If you would like to organize a green workshop, cultural activity, or share a skill with the group, please let us know in your application! We will provide you with the space and materials to make it happen!



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# Follow-up Activities



## Obligations of Participants After Returning Home

- **Local Events:** Each participant will organize a minimum 1 event in their community (at least one event in every local community where participants are active).
- **Training & Mentoring:** Conduct training sessions for young people within their organization post-PDA, mentor them, and report project results.
- **Entrepreneur Fair:** Organize an event to connect young people with a successful entrepreneur within their organization.

## Requirements for the Events

- Share their learning outcomes and project experiences on social media (photos, videos, blog posts, or reels).
- Disseminate project results online and offline, raise awareness about environmental protection and sustainable lifestyles.

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# Costs and reimbursement

- The project is co-funded through the Erasmus+ program, which means that accommodation, food, materials, the program, and travel costs up to the maximum allowed amount are fully covered.
- According to the rules of the Erasmus+ program, if your travel costs are higher than the maximum reimbursable amount explained in the previous slide, the difference is covered by you.
- To be eligible for reimbursement, we ask you to keep all your tickets, boarding passes, and invoices (originals). ONLY if you have the travel tickets, boarding passes, and invoices we can reimburse your travel cost.
- The reimbursement is done at the end of day of the project by hand, once you send us the originals of the tickets and took part in all the phases of the project.
- We will only reimburse your travel costs if you participate in the whole project, the follow-up, and the evaluation after the mobility.

## ☒ **Valid Passport or ID Card**

Required for both international and domestic flights/bus travel.

## ☒ **Travel and Health Insurance**

It must be valid in Romania. We strongly recommend obtaining an extra travel insurance covering luggage loss, travel delays, and medical expenses.

## ☒ **Personal Medication**

If you take any medicine regularly, please bring enough for the entire duration of the project.

## ☒ **Comfortable Clothing**

For indoor workshops and outdoor activities, including eco-visits and farm work.

## ☒ **Good Walking Shoes (preferably waterproof)**

You will need them during farm visits, excursions, and city walks.

## ☒ **Raincoat / Windbreaker**

The weather can change unexpectedly.

Including personal items such as shampoo, soap, toothbrush, etc.
